

LEW MOQUIN

Lew Moquin, "The Car Seat Guy," has been an advocate for car seat safety since 1998, volunteering his time and expertise with ensuring families across the county can safely transport their children, providing certified child passenger safety



technicians (CCPSTs) at a variety of locations throughout Genesee County.

Since 2017, through partnership with Mott Children's Hospital, Genesee County Community Action Resource Department (GCCARD), and Genesee Health Plan (GHP), Lew, and his team of volunteer CCPSTs, have hosted monthly community car seat checks and installations at the GHP office, and Mott Community College's Lenore Croudy Family Life Center. They have inspected more than 1,100 car seats and have provided more than 880 new car seats to low-income families in the community, through a Michigan program that enables at-risk families to receive free car seats, if needed.

In 2019, Lew received grant funding from the Michigan Office of Highway Safety Planning to increase the number of CCPSTs in Genesee County, expanding their reach in assisting even more families. Through the grant, Lew held a four-day long certification training class at Genesee Health Plan.

From organizing and coordinating pop-up car seat safety checks to regularly scheduled checks at partner locations, Lew goes above and beyond to help the youngest and most vulnerable residents, providing a local voice at the state level, advocating for stronger car seat laws. With his advocacy and partnership with other certified passenger safety technicians, Governor Gretchen Whitmer signed



legislation in March, Public Act 21 and 22 of 2024, strengthening car seat laws and requirements for children ages 2-13. Lew and his volunteers continue to be a vital part of the safety of the Genesee County community.

AIMEE ALLOR

Aimee Allor has worked alongside Lew Moquin ensuring families are safely transporting their children and have access to car seats since she began working at Genesee County Community Action Resource Department's HeadStart Program in 2016.



Volunteering her time, and being

passionate about serving low-income, underserved communities, her favorite part of the car seat inspection program is empowering families to help them advocate for themselves and the safety of their children by teaching them how to keep themselves and their family safe. Through this work, relationships naturally develop between CCPSTs and the families they help; she sees repeat families coming back. From expecting moms to foster agencies, Aimee, Lew, and all of the volunteers in this project make sure that everyone they help leaves safer.

In 2017, GHP was brought on as a partner, hosting car seat checks on the 4th Friday of the month, providing a reliable, consistent location, where community members can get an inspection and come into the office for additional resources from health care coverage to utility and food assistance programs. Aimee is grateful for the continued partnership with GHP, providing a safe space for new parents and families who are lost, confused, and scared when it comes to care seat safety, handling each case with comfort and care.

PETER LEVINE

Peter Levine dedicated his career to advocating for access to quality health care and played a key role in the launch of the Genesee Health Plan (GHP) in 2001. Through his leadership with the Genesee County Medical Society (GCMS), he worked with physicians in response to the Flint Water Crisis, researching and analyzing its significant impacts on public health and safety, and publicly advising the community of



physician recommendations on how to reduce risk based on exposure.

Levine's work with GHP and GCMS serves as a testament to his unwavering commitment to public health. As we remember Peter Levine, we honor his contributions and the lasting positive change he brought to countless lives.

REP. TIM SNELLER

State Representative Tim Sneller was a passionate advocate for health care. A longtime supporter of the GHP and its millage renewal efforts, he volunteered for the millage campaign in 2005 and continued his commitment throughout his career. During his first term in office, he made health care a top priority and partnered with GHP in various capacities, including hosting a Health Insurance Enrollment Forum and volunteering for GHP drive-thru immunization events.

2024 AWARDS

The Medical Leadership Award honors a medical leader who provides exemplary quality of care, serves as a patient advocate, and demonstrates a commitment to strengthening health care in our community.

DR. NATHAN KOPEK

Throughout his career, Dr. Nathan Kopek was known for his compassion, warmth and dedication to his patients, colleagues, and residents. In 2007, Dr. Kopek completed post graduate training in Internal Medicine and joined Ascension Genesys as Faculty, serving as Program Director of the Osteopathic Recognition Track, and Associate Program Director of the Internal Medicine Residency Program.



Through his medical leadership, he supported the residency program by training residents and students in Osteopathic Manipulative Therapy and outpatient procedures. He took great pride in mentoring his residents, guiding them to fulfill their aspirations and make a tangible difference in the lives of their patients and community.

Dr. Kopek was deeply involved in the study and treatment of autoimmune disorders, infectious disease, and diabetes. As a devoted member of the Genesee Health Plan Board of Directors from 2013-2023, and serving on its Network Quality and Oversight Committee as Chair from 2012-2023, he provided guidance and expertise in assisting GHP leadership with formulary recommendations, health navigation and chronic disease management services that the plan provides.

Dr. Kopek passed away in 2023 after a lengthy illness. We thank Dr. Kopek for his unwavering dedication and contributions to GHP, the community, and the many lives he touched throughout his career and life.



The Health Care Hall of Fame Inductee Visionary Leadership Award honors visionary leaders who personally made a lasting impact on the community's health care landscape. Through dedication, advocacy, leadership and tenacity, the Health Care Hall of Fame inductees have helped to improve the health of the community.

DR. LAURA CARRAVALLAH

Dr. Laura Carravallah has dedicated her work to improving access to quality healthcare for Genesee County. During the Flint Water Crisis, Dr. Carravallah collaborated with academic organizations, Genesee Health Plan (GHP), and more to organize response efforts on behalf of her role on the Community and Environmental Health Committee of the Genesee County Medical Society from 2016-2020. From



2012-2023, she served on the Genesee County Board of Health, helping steer health policy to positively impact county residents. Dr. Carravallah served on the GHP Board of Directors from 2018-2023, the Physician Advisory Committee, and has advocated for the health plan throughout her career.

She has been a fierce and powerful advocate for GHP since the plan began. As President of the Genesee County Medical Society, she played a key role in securing physician support for the Health Care Services Millage. During the 2012 GHP Health Care Services Millage renewal, she wrote numerous articles and letters, including one publication in the Flint Journal, that made a compelling case for passage of the millage, as well as supporting the millage during a news press conference. She has provided a voice for the uninsured and voiceless in our community.

Dr. Carravallah led two research projects with residency students from the MSU Department of Public Health, in partnership with GHP. These research projects focused on the lack of pharmacies in the City of Flint, and identifying and establishing ancillary services for cancer patients, including resources for caregivers. These projects were invaluable in teaching the residency students to identify disparities among racial and ethnic minorities, geographic location, and barriers to accessing health care in Flint and Genesee County, where these students were attending school.
